

**GUILDERLAND CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT
IMMUNIZATION POLICY
Updated July 2015**

Public Health Law 2164 requires that those children entering
School must meet the following vaccine requirements:

1. **3-5 doses of DTP or DTaP** (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis) **Obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.*
 2. **3-4 doses of IPV/OPV** (polio) **For the 4th dose, obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.*
 3. **2 doses of MMR vaccine** (measles, mumps, rubella) **For the 2nd dose, obtaining in age range of 4-6 years is no longer permitted.*
 4. **3 doses of Hepatitis B**
 5. **1-2 doses of Varicella** (chicken pox)*
 6. **1 dose of Tdap** (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) **For students entering sixth grade*
- *Number of doses dependent on grade level, please speak to your physician.*

A student will not be admitted unless a person in parental relation to the student furnishes the entering school with one of the following:

1. A certificate of immunization signed by the administering physician
2. A signed statement from the physician stating medical reason for exemption
